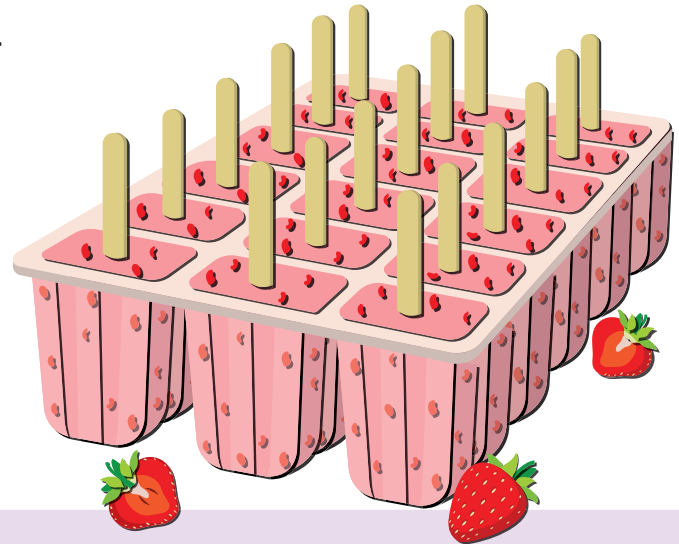


Big Idea OF THE CHAPTER

Family Activities and Investigations
